#### Dr. Babita Poudel

Dr. Babita Paudel has been appointed as the Humboldt Ambassador Scientist to Nepal by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, Germany for 2023-2025.

Dr. Babita Paudel, a Humboldt Ambassador Scientist of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, Germany, served as a jury member at the Falling Walls Lab held on July 20, 2024, in Kathmandu, Nepal. The event took place at the Kathmandu University School of Management (KUSOM) in Lalitpur, Kathmandu, and was supported by Falling Walls, Germany, DAAD India, and the German Federal Foreign Office.

Dr. Babita Paudel was selected for the 2024 Humboldt Residency Program in Berlin, Germany, scheduled from August 5 to September 13, 2024. This year's residency, themed "Power and Knowledge: Confronting Global Imbalances in Our Knowledge Systems," brought together 11 international participants from diverse fields, including research, journalism, and activism. The program facilitated an exchange of ideas, amplified local voices in the global knowledge system, and explored ways to structure knowledge exchange between the Global North and Global South within the scientific community and beyond. The initiative aimed to leverage existing knowledge and integrate the perspectives of local actors into global strategies.

In February 2024, Dr. Babita Paudel was an invited speaker at the conference on Recent Trends in Science, Technology, and Innovation held in Pokhara, Nepal, where she had the opportunity to present her research.

#### Dr. Shekhar Aryal

Dr. Shekhar Aryal successfully defended his Ph.D. in Mechanical (Hydro-Power and Renewable Energy) Engineering . And he was awarded the Ph.D. degree at the convocation held in 28 December, 2024.

#### Dr. Ram Prasad Dhital

The meeting of the Council of Ministers on June 24, 2024 appointed Dr Ram Prasad Dhital as the Chairman of the Electricity Regulatory Commission (ERC), Nepal. The key functions of the commission are to regulate the generation, transmission, distribution and trade of electricity in Nepal by introducing and enforcing various regulatory instruments specially in the technical, economical, institutional, grievance handling and dispute resolution aspects of the electricity sector in Nepal. Dr Dhital was briefly associated with the Commission as a member in 2019.

Previously he served as the Executive Director of Alternative Energy Promotion Center for a full term of four years under the Ministry of Energy, Water Resources, and Irrigation overseeing "Renewable Energy" operations, strategic and technical initiatives in Nepal. He also worked as (i) a visiting Professor at KU, (ii) an Advisor to the Infrastructure Committee of the Parliament and (iii) an Electricity Policy and Regulatory Expert for ADB Nepal, UNDP Afghanistan, UNDP Yemen, UNDP Fiji for Vanuatu, and AusAID Vanuatu and FCDO-PwC FSSP Nepal.

We are looking forward to collaborating with an international, interdisciplinary group of board members to work for the betterment of diaspora members in both their countries of origin and destination.

As a co-organizer of the Diaspora Summit—Diaspora Beyond 2030—for the second consecutive time, Mr. Adhikari actively fosters cross-cultural and social engagement. He played a leading role in organizing this event at the Bundestag and BMZ for the first time. It was one of the most successful events, attended by Members of Parliament (MdB) and other dignitaries. Additionally, in mid-May, he met Minister Svenja Schulze and handed over the position paper for the betterment of Diasporas in Germany.

In September 2024, another prestigious position was awarded to Mr. Adhikari. He was appointed by the Hessian Ministry for Labor, Integration, Youth, and Social Affairs as a member of the Hessian Integration Conference, advising the ministry on migration and integration policies. In December, he was invited by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diaspora in Kosovo as a speaker at the famous Ulpiana Forum. Together with speakers from various countries, he presented his views and made a clear statement. He said: "You cannot stop migration, but you can harness it for both the countries of origin and destination."

#### Prof. Dr. Tanka Nath Dhamala

He is the former President of NEGAAS, was funded with Research Group Linkage Program from Alexander von Humboldt Foundation for the research project entitled "Optimization Strategies for Congestion Reduction in Emergency Planning". Prof. Dr. Dhamala is the Principal Resource Person from Central Department of Mathematics at Tribhuvan University and Prof. Dr. Stefan Nickel is the Principal Resource Person from Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT), Institute for Operations Research, Discrete Optimization and Logistics. The project aims to minimize traffic congestion in Kathmandu which is designed to complete with research exchanges and workshops during the period 2024-2026.

Professor Dhamala was nominated, together with other two more candidates, for the post of Vice-Chancellor after several meritocratic evaluation processes of Nepal government. However, he could not be appointed for the responsibility.

#### Dr. Ganga Datta Nepal

In September 2024, he was appointed an honorable Vice Chairperson of Policy and Planning Commission (PPPC) of Bagmati Province. He has to serve as a development and planning adviser of Chief Minister and lead the policy formation and planning process of the Province.

PPPC is a specialized agency that formulates policies and plans of the provincial government based on research and study. It also analyse to accelerate towards prosperity from balanced sustainable development. It also provides advice and support to provincial government on planning, monitoring and evaluation.


